

Oakworth Village Show categories

- 1) **3 HENS' EGGS** (Displayed on a plate)
 - 2) **5 POTATOES** (Any colour. Need to bear a card stating the variety. If the variety is unknown that must be stated.)
 - 3) **2 COURGETTES** (Need to bear a card stating the variety. If the variety is unknown that must be stated.)
 - 4) **6 TOMATOES** (Need to bear a card stating the variety. If the variety is unknown that must be stated.)
 - 5) **6 BEAN OR PEA PODS** (Need to bear a card stating the variety. If the variety is unknown that must be stated.)
 - 6) **A POT OF HERBS**
 - 7) **ANY OTHER VEGETABLE**
 - 8) **HEAVIEST MARROW**
 - 9) **6 OF ANY FRUIT**
 - 10) **VICTORIA SPONGE** (Official recipe. See over the page. No deviations allowed)
 - 11) **TRAY BAKE**
 - 12) **6 BISCUITS**
 - 13) **4 SCONES** (Sweet or savoury. Displayed on a plate)
 - 14) **A LOAF OF BREAD**
 - 15) **A JAR OF PRESERVE**

- (15 and 16) All jars must be clean and full to the top, have no trademarks or names on them and be labelled with contents and date (day, month and year) and must be less than 12 months old. Do not open your jar before the show. The judge reserves the right not to test any jar which has been opened before judging
- 17) **BEER/WINE/CIDER** (one bottle)
 - 18) **A HAND-MADE NEEDLECRAFT ITEM** (Embroidery, sewing, knitting, crochet. No larger than 18 inches)
 - 19) **A HAND-MADE ITEM – OTHER MEDIA** (No larger than 18 inches)
 - 20) **A PHOTO - LOCAL** (Unframed, no larger than 5x 7inches)
 - 21) **A PHOTO - PETS** (Unframed, no larger than 5x 7inches)



- 22) A PAINTING** (Any media. No larger than A3)
- 23) GARDEN FLOWERS IN A JAM JAR**
- 24) A FLOWER ARRANGEMENT IN AN UNUSUAL CONTAINER**
- 25) 3 ROSES** (grown)

Children's classes

Children are not restricted to only entering classes in this section but may enter any other section. They may also enter any class intended for older children.

Show rules, conditions of entry and tips

- 1) **Entries must be submitted by 7pm on Sunday 14th July to Oakworth Village hall.**
- 2) Entrance fees are 30p for each entry to each class.
- 3) Fix name labels to cake tins, plates, display equipment but not where it is visible when judging occurs.
- 4) The hall will be open for staging at 8.00am on the day of the show. Exhibits must be staged before 10am. Stewards will be available to provide assistance if required.
- 5) The hall will be open for general viewing between 12.30 and 4pm.
- 6) It is hoped that exhibitors will allow their exhibits to be sold by auction for the benefit of funds. If you do not wish them to be sold, please remove them by 3.30pm but not before 3pm.
- 7) All exhibits must be the bona fide property of and grown, made or collected by the exhibitor.
- 8) Flowers for the flower arrangement may be bought.
- 9) No commercial mixes allowed in the cookery classes.
- 10) The committee will take reasonable care of exhibits and property etc. but will not hold themselves responsible for any loss or damage.
- 11) Exhibitors may enter no more than two entries per class. Children are limited to one entry per class.
- 12) The committee reserve the right to inspect the garden or allotment of an exhibitor (classes 2 to 9).
- 13) The decision of the judges is final but any protest relating to misrepresentation or any breach of the rules should be made in writing not later than 3.30pm on the day of the show and should be handed to the show coordinator who can make any further decisions.
- 14) All entrants must be amateurs in the field in which they have entered and not receive payment in any way for their work.
- 15) Any competitor not complying with the rules will forfeit any prize and their exhibit will be removed from public display.
- 16) Prize money for adult classes will be 1st prize £3, 2nd prize £2, 3rd prize £1. Medals will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd places in the childrens' classes

Victoria sponge – official recipe.

Ingredients – sponge

4oz (110g) butter, at room temperature
4oz (110g) caster sugar
2 large eggs
4oz (110g) self-raising flour, sifted
a few drops of vanilla essence

Ingredients – filling and topping

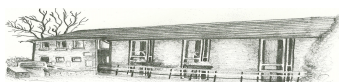
About 4 tablespoons of raspberry or strawberry jam (Jam does not need to be home made)
Sifted icing sugar

Method

Oven temp 170C / 325F / Gas mark 3

Cream the butter and sugar together until pale and fluffy. In a separate bowl beat the eggs thoroughly then add them a little at a time beating well after each addition. When the eggs have been incorporated add a few drops of vanilla essence and then fold in the flour. Divide equally between two 7 inch (18cm) lined tins.

Bake for approx 25 minutes. When cold, sandwich together with the jam and sprinkle icing sugar on top.
